

God's Pre-Game Pep Talk

Psalm 27

Group Discussion Questions

(Select Questions that Will Create Discussion in Your Group)

Read Psalm 27

Pastor Cade said that we are all called to play our part in God's game plan of the Great Commission (Matthew 28:18-20). As we consider these questions, ask yourself, "What role do I play in the Great Commission?" and, "What does God want me to do for His Great Commission?"

Any confidence we have comes *only* from our trust in God alone – not from anything or anyone else. What are things do you commonly put your faith in?

What are some things or who is someone you trust to get you through life's trials? How is this ungodly?

Pastor Cade called attention to those who wrongly trust their *faith*, instead of trusting God, by twisting Scriptures, like Mark 11:24. False teachers twist this and other verses to claim that God will give you anything you ask Him for, as long as you believe it. How do we guard ourselves against false teachers of this and other errors of interpretation and application of the Bible?

How have you seen your trust in God grow recently? Over the last few years? Over your life? What methods does God use to grow your faith?

Describe a time when you earnestly sought God's face.

Describe a time when God required you to wait patiently for Him. How hard a struggle was this for you? What did God teach you in your struggle?

What are you struggling with today, whether for His coming, His healing, or for His justice or peace? How is God using your present struggle to grow your trust in Him?

Assignments for Next Meeting:

Pray for each member of your group by name this week.

Tell someone about Jesus – Who's Your One?

Read Psalm 27 every day this week.

Be prepared to share how God is working in you at the next meeting.
