Group Discussion Questions

(Select Questions that Will Create Discussion in Your Group)

Read Psalm 103

What are some ways God has blessed you? Be specific.

How do you feel realizing that God has *totally* forgiven you? Knowing some of the things that you have done, describe your thanks and praise to God knowing that He has totally forgiven those things.

Do you ever have trouble forgiving yourself for something you have done? How does Satan use your past sins against you? How does the Holy Spirit testify within you that you are forgiven and made completely clean and whole in God's sight?

Pastor Cade said that because God is holy and just, He will either forgive or punish. Those who are saved are forgiven. All others are punished. How does this reality motivate you to share Jesus with your lost friends?

What does it mean to you that God sent His only Son whom He loved to die on a torturous cross so that you could receive eternal life? See 2 Corinthians 5:21.

God knows you and loves you with a relentlessly limitless love. How should you, then, love others?

Despite how unreliable, how weak, how sinful, how stubborn, and how needy we are, how has the Lord responded to you in unbelievable ways?

Since God loved us long before we even knew Him, how can we extend Christ's love to those who are lost?

Since God reigns with dominion over all, how can we show Him thanks, praise, and worship?
